People were amazed and inspired by Alexei's determination to keep going, no matter what, never giving up. Alexei's greatest joy was found in performing for people and in encouraging and inspiring them. He passed away in his sleep on June 30, 2005.

The spirit of Alexei - a colorful fountain in Fort Worth with water splashing eternally to the accompaniment of Alexei's beautiful music - will represent inspiration, strength and courage. Alexei would be proud. "Alexei - a comet that raced across this planet during his 35 years, touching the hearts and minds of everyone in his path. Like a comet's tail, the Alexei Sultanov Foundation will continue the dazzling influence of that very special human being," said Alexei's wife, Dace.

The Alexei Sultanov Foundation's mission is to provide financial, emotional and psychological support to musicians and other performing artists who are no longer able to perform and make a living due to severe illness or injury. This Foundation encourages families who are facing such monumental challenges to never give up, never let go, and to stand by their loved ones, providing compassionate support and care during devastating times.
