

These 2 buses cover more than 90 hotels in Lisbon, providing tourists arriving at Lisbon Airport, easy access to their accommodation.

Carris bus service also provides commuter buses between Lisbon Airport and downtown (numbers 44, 83 and 745). Bus nº 44 does not allow luggage and on weekends only runs until Marques Pombal Square. METRO (Subway / Underground):

BY TAXI:



Taxis are available outside the terminals at Lisbon Airport. All taxis that operate in Lisbon are fully licensed and can either be light beje or black and green.

Taxi rate system for tariff 1 (Lisbon City):

The minimum fare of $\leq 2,00$ (is already marked on the meter as you enter the taxi), and the price per Km is $\leq 0,45$ for day journeys between 06.00 Hrs and 21.00 Hrs.

For journeys between 21.00 Hrs and 06.00 Hrs the minimum fare is €2,50 and the price per Km is €0,54. These fares also apply on Saturdays, Sundays and Public Holidays from 00.00 Hrs to 24.00 Hrs.

Supplements will apply for telephone booking and for luggage.
