

2009 FUNERAL PRICE SURVEY

The comprehensive funeral price survey on pages 2 and 3 reveals a classic good-news, bad-news situation. The bad news is that prices continue going up, this time in the face of a recession. The good news is that consumers are getting smarter and are finding ways to economize.

The price of a standard funeral in the Kansas City area is \$6,177, an increase of \$616 from the 2007 average of \$5,561. The 11% price boost is triple the 3.6% increase in consumer prices here during the same period. The new \$6,177 average cost includes the lowest-priced caskets and grave liners listed by area funeral homes and does not include cemetery costs.

Ironically, economic pressures induced by the recession are influencing full-service funeral homes to raise their prices. Consumers are more cost conscious than ever. They are moving to the lower-cost alternatives of cremation and to low-cost funeral providers. The price increases for traditional funerals represent an attempt to make up for lost revenues.


"When money is an issue, loyalty (to a particular funeral home) is one thing, but cost is another thing," said Mack Smith, executive secretary of the Kansas Board of Mortuary Arts, a state consumer protection agency. "The unemployment rate is up. Money is the number one factor everywhere."

Cheers for good news

Finally it is happening. Increasingly, families are examining their options for thrifty, meaningful funerals and not accepting the prices of a single source without question. This price survey makes comparing prices easy.

Our volunteers donated their time, talents and resources. Will you please help cover our costs with your tax-deductible gift in the enclosed envelope? It has been a long-time goal of the Funeral Consumers Alliance of Greater Kansas City (FCA-GKC) that consumers should compare prices at more than one funeral home. The Kansas City area reflects the national growth in cremations to the current level of about 35%.

The cremation rate now is 65% at the area's two lowestcost providers, Marts Memorial in Westport and Kansas City Funeral Directors in Wyandotte County. Both reported robust volumes this year. At \$3,560, K.C. Funeral Directors has the lowest price in the survey for a standard funeral and Marts has the second lowest at \$3,670. Marts posted the lowest price, \$675, for a direct cremation followed by K.C. Funeral Directors'



Leading the way in price increases last time were 19 area funeral homes owned by two national chains, Service Corporation International (McGilley, Mount Moriah and Chapel Hill-Butler) and Stewart Enterprises (Newcomer's). In this survey, the Newcomer's properties posted increases from 20% to 37% while SCI posted more modest gains of 5% to 11%. Only one funeral home in this survey had a higher price than the \$8,390 amount posted by the area's eight Newcomer's (Stewart) properties. That one is \$8,560 at the locally owned Chapel of Memories in Grain Valley, affiliated with Swan Lake Cemetery, an increase of 45%.

Four funeral homes actually reduced their prices in the new survey compared with the last survey when none did.

The job of culling over 800 prices from 77 funeral home price lists was performed by Kate Bengtson, a social studies graduate student at the University of Iowa under the direction of Aging Studies Professor Mercedes Bern-Klug, a former member of FCA-GKC's board. The two women logged 41 volunteer hours assembling the chart on pages 2 and 3. Lyle VanVleet, a Shawnee income tax preparer, volunteered 13 hours inserting the 2007 survey results and finishing the chart. FCA-GKC and area consumers owe them a debt of gratitude.

FCA-GKC sent letters with self-addressed envelopes to all of the funeral homes requesting their Federal Trade Commission-mandated General Price Lists. About half cooperated by return mail. FCA-GKC board members collected the remaining price lists in person. The FTC's Funeral Rule requires funeral homes to produce their price lists when requested in person.

Bern-Klug said she was shocked at some of the price increases and at the high number of Funeral Rule violations she and Bengtson found in the General Price Lists. For instance, the average prices for basic services and embalming both increased 16 percent, more than four times the increase in the Consumer Price Index. Basic services, the fee funeral homes charge to cover their overhead costs, is the only charge among nine items in a standard funeral that consumers cannot decline.

Josh Slocum, executive director of the national Funeral Consumers Alliance, agrees that the basic services fee in many price lists has become excessive.

"The basic service fee was meant to be a modest charge for the services provided to every customer, not an artificial profit support," he writes in the FCA's guide for funeral directors. "Charging high prices for basic services isn't fair. Overhead should be spread out among the items you actually sell so customers pay their fair share, not more."

The FCA's guide, "Consumer-Friendly General Price Lists," is available at the national office in South Burlington, VT by calling 800-765-0107.

"A confusing price list agitates customers who are already upset," Slocum states. "But a clear, plain-language, legally compliant price list goes a long way toward heading off confusion and hard feelings. An informed customer is a satisfied customer."
