

The 40th reunion committee of the Brandywine High School Class of '67 welcomes you this evening to this beautifully restored neighborhood landmark, The Blue Ball Dairy Barn. We are so glad to see each and every one of you -- we were all part of a very special era growing up and graduating from Brandywine -- and will forever have that bond among us.

Some history... On June 15, 1967, the Board of Trustees of the Alfred I. duPont School District granted diplomas to 521 members of the Brandywine High School Class of 1967. At the time, it was the largest class to have graduated from a high school in the history of Delaware. Although the district did not name a valedictorian or salutatorian it did recognize six Distinguished Scholars: Patricia Auspos, Fern Breslow, Deborah Chavenson, William Cornell, Michael Davis, Alan Jones and Richard Plambeck. Sherry Markwalder and Christopher Little were named winners of the Brandywine Awards, which honored students who best personified a well rounded student and leader. At graduation time, ninety percent of our class had plans to continue our educations received at Brandywine.

We of "Da Committee" (as we call ourselves) have been in almost daily contact through the internet since our last reunion at Harry's in 2002. We've had a handful of 5-way phone calls and met in person once last fall. We enjoyed playing detective via Zaba Search and Intellus, calling strangers to see if they are in fact who we were looking for. Hours were spent pouring over the '67 Azurean, copies of the Brandywine Line, graduation programs and newspaper clippings for the past five years and I think now, some of us know your18-year-old smiling faces better than some of our own grown kids'! We located a grand total of 400 of the original 521.

Here we are united again, forty years later, a little more or a little less (literally) than we were back then. We hope you have as much fun this evening as we have had bringing it all together.
