## Unit 448's new Recorder: DONNA DECHENNE

Recorder Regulations and Procedures:
GOAL: The aim of the recorder system is to establish a method of dealing with complaints that: 1) by themselves do not warrant the filing of formal charges; 2) are very serious but there is only the implication of wrongdoing without substantial evidence necessary to bring formal charges or 3 ) are a request to have the subject's behavior modified by counseling and/or education.
Our previous recorder, Bruce Cook, has moved and his Unit affiliation has changed. Donna Dechenne has agreed to take on this task in representing our Unit and District. By being our Unit's Recorder, she is automatically affiliated with District 19 and ACBL for any actions that occur in our area at the time. We are planning to give our members more information on her duties and responsibilities.
COMPLAINT: A written accusation by an ACBL member, a non- member playing in an ACBL sanctioned event, ACBL management or a Unit o District alleging conduct in violation of the CDR 3 that request that charges be made to the appropriate disciplinary body.
FILE: The collection of written documents that include the player memo, any written response, all investigative notes and other documents.
PLAYER MEMO: A written document informing the Recorder about an incident. This is not a complaint but may be used as the basis for a complaint.
DUTIES: Receives, investigates and evaluates player memos. Maintains a record of all player memos, including investigation and resolution.
A recorder has no disciplinary authority. A recorder may file a complaint with the appropriate disciplinary body as a means to resolve a player memo.

## Keep It Simple-A Good System

A doctor is called away from a bridge tournament to tend to an emergency. There is still the last board to play. They ask a kibitzer to take his place, although he knows nothing about the game.
They tell him "Just bid what you have got and follow suit". He, sitting South, starts the bidding sequence:

This is the deal


South took the lead of the king of spades with the ace, cashed the ace and king of trumps, came to hand with the ace of clubs and played all his diamonds. On the last one, West was hopelessly squeezed in hearts and spades, and ultimately discarded a heart, whereupon South made the last four tricks in hearts. When the opposition realized South's hand they called the director, who asked for an explanation of the bidding, and got the following reply: "I was told to bid what I have got, and I have one club, two spades, 3 hearts and 7 diamonds".

District Charity Grants Begin in 2005
In an effort to respond to the needs of charity in our local areas, the ACBL Charity Foundation in 2005 will began issuing grants to districts rather than granting one $\$ 100,000$ contribution to a national Charity of the Year.
The districts will be included in a four-year cycle with the exceptions of Districts 1 and 2, where charity funds are collected by the Canadian Bridge Federation. Districts 18 and 19 will share one grant with District 19 receiving $\mathbf{6 0 \%}$ and District 18 receiving $\mathbf{4 0 \%}$ for the first four-year cycle. The districts will be given grants in the following years:
2005 4, 5, 6, 7, 11, 17; 2006 3, 13, 16, 20, 24; 2007 8, 9, 10, 14, 21, 23; 2008 12, 15, 18, 19, 22, 25.
