I can never forget my weekend experience in 1999 – one of the significant spiritual experiences of my walk with God in Christ. In northern Alabama, given the large Christian population, there were over 25 walks every year with each walk attended by nearly 40 pilgrims. On Thursday evening, I walked into the conference room with absolutely no expectations and left the conference room on Sunday evening, bathed by the Holy Spirit and prayed on by so many wonderful spirits – needless to say the desire to stay yielded to the power of the Spirit in my life has never faded since then.
